**THE KIWANIS CLUB OF CALDWELL** – The Kiwanis Club of Caldwell will award a scholarship to a graduating senior. Criteria will be based on community involvement and financial need.

**FAIRFIELD SCHOLARSHIP FUND** – The purpose of the Fairfield Scholarship Fund is to provide financial assistance for high school graduates residing in Fairfield (Fairfield resident) who are entering their first year of college or a postsecondary education program.

**TIMOTHY C. MC WILLIAMS JR. FOUNDATION** – This scholarship is open to all senior students attending a college or vocational institute in September.

**DR. Students should be in top half of their graduating class and have demonstrated a high degree of industriousness. Scholarship recipients will be asked to report their progress.
