FAIRFIELD SCHOLARSHIP FUND – The purpose of the Fairfield Scholarship Fund is to provide financial assistance for high school graduates residing in Fairfield (Fairfield resident) who are entering their first year of college or a postsecondary education program.

TIMOTHY C. MC WILLIAMS JR. FOUNDATION – This scholarship is open to all senior students attending a college or vocational institute in September.

HARVEY ROSSINOW & NORMAL ROSSINOW MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP – A scholarship to honor the memory of Dr. Harvey Rossinow was established at West Essex High School, by Caldwell Dental Associates in 1997, and added in 2002, in memory of Norman Rossinow who was declared missing on September 11 2001 from the World Trade Center. Graduating seniors who will be attending a four year college or university in September may apply for this scholarship which will be granted for one year of undergraduate study. Students should be in top half of their graduating class and have demonstrated a high degree of industriousness. Scholarship recipients will be asked to report their progress.
