NEW JERSEY SOCIETY OF CERTIFIED PUBLIC ACCOUNTANTS

Requirements: - High School senior planning to enter college
 - Must major or have a concentration in accounting in college
 - Have a GPA of 3.0 OR SAT combined score of 1500, or ACT score of 23

DEADLINE DATE TO GUIDANCE: DECEMBER 16, 2009

NEW JERSEY VIETNAM VETERANS' MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Requirements: - New Jersey resident
 - Graduating high school senior
 - Applicant has visited the memorial site
 - Applicant has written an essay about their visit

DEADLINE DATE TO GUIDANCE: APRIL 9, 2010

AXA ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP

Requirements: - United States citizen or legal resident
 - Current high school senior who plans to enroll full-time in an accredited two-year or four-year college or university in the fall of 2010
 - Demonstrate ambition and self-drive as evidenced by outstanding achievement in an activity in school, the community or the work place
 - Be recommended by an unrelated adult who can attest to the student's achievement

DEADLINE DATE TO GUIDANCE: DECEMBER 11, 2009

NORTHERN NEW JERSEY MENSA – MENSA EDUCATION AND RESEARCH FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS

ELIGIBILITY for MENSA Scholarships: The only eligibility requirements are that the applicant be enrolled, for the academic year following the award, in a degree program in an accredited American institute of postsecondary education, and be a resident of the area of a participating local group of American Mensa. For the general awards, the applicant need not be a member of Mensa nor qualified for Mensa, and the general awards are unrestricted as to age, race, gender, level of post-secondary education and financial need.

2010 SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE DISABLED AMERICAN VETERANS – The New Jersey Disabled American Veterans will be awarding three scholarships to graduating high school seniors for post high school education.

- Requirements:
- Applicant must be a New Jersey resident
 - Applicant must be a natural or adopted descendant of a member of the Disabled American Veterans, Department of new Jersey (Son, Daughter, Grandson, or Granddaughter)
 - Applicant must provide proof of relationship and that the veteran is a member of the Disabled American Veterans
