

## Tuition-Free Community College Now Available



### How Community College Opportunity Grants make Community College affordable:

Community College Opportunity Grants are awards that will pay the costs of tuition and approved educational fees not already covered by other available grant funds applied to the student's account.

### Who is eligible for tuition-free Community College:

Community College Opportunity Grants are available to students who meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Enrolled in at least six (6) credits per semester at any community college during Academic Year 2020-2021
- Does not have a prior college degree
- Completed a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or the New Jersey Alternative Financial Aid Application according to agency deadlines at [www.njgrants.org](http://www.njgrants.org)
- Make satisfactory academic progress
- Have a total household adjusted gross income between \$0 - \$65,000
