Welcome to Geometry! Geometry CPA is a college preparatory course which emphasizes topics inherent to Euclidean geometry. Knowledge of geometry will be developed with an emphasis on its logical structure and problem solving with consideration of both the inductive and deductive methods of reasoning as applied to formal proofs.

Required Materials: Compass, protractor, ruler, TI-84 calculator, pencils (for all assessments), colored pens/pencils for homework corrections, and a **binder** with folders and loose-leaf paper.

Summer Assignment: Your summer assignment for Geometry CPA is on **Delta Math**, which you will need a computer with Internet access. This is <u>due the first day of school</u> and is worth a **10 point homework grade.** Please follow the directions posted below to access it:

1) Log in **or** create an account on <u>www.deltamath.com</u>

If you HAVE a login already...

- Sign into your account
- Go to "Tools" and then "Manage Login and Teachers"
- Add the teacher code: 247432 and select "Geometry CPA"

If you DO NOT HAVE a login:

- Click "Create Account" then type in teacher code: 247432
- Make a username (using your @westex.org email) and password
- Type in your first and last name
- Select "Geometry CPA" from the drop down menu
- 2) Go back to your homepage. You should see the "Geometry CPA Summer Assignment" with various topics.
