Superintendent's Report

- COVID-19 Weekly Activity Report

- Enhanced protocols as per NJDOH
- School Physician, District Nurses, & Public Health Department

Enhanced Protocols

- Unvaccinated close contacts will be excluded from school for 14 days without a test (individuals are permitted to provide negative test results collected at 6-8 days and return on day 10 - *currently day 8*).
- Vaccinated close contacts must get tested at 5-7 days after exposure (quarantine is not required while waiting for test results).
- Unvaccinated individuals must self-quarantine for 10 days after domestic travel without a test. Individuals are permitted to get tested 3-5 days after travel and provide negative test results to return on day 8 *currently no earlier than day 4* (NY, PA, and DE excluded).
- Unvaccinated/Vaccinated individuals who have been diagnosed with COVID-19 in the past 90 days do <u>not</u> need to be excluded from school.
- All tests must be PCR/Molecular (rapid antigen tests are not accepted for testing out of quarantine).
