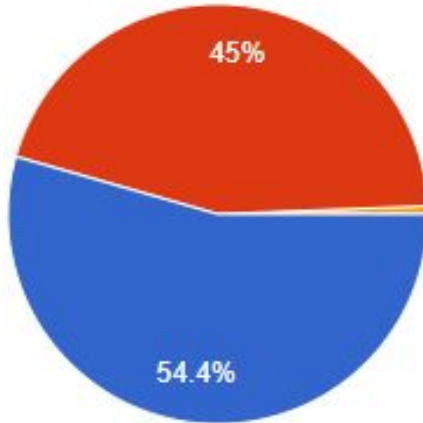


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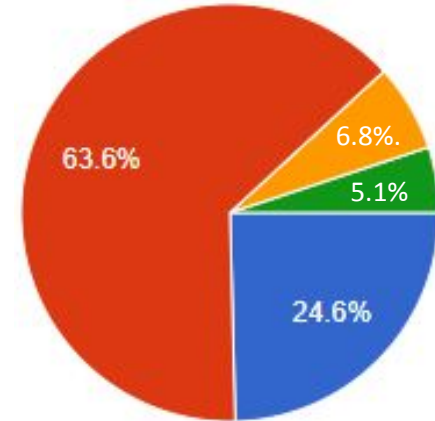
AMOUNT OF HOMEWORK

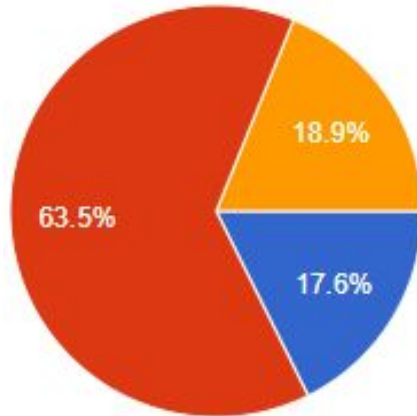

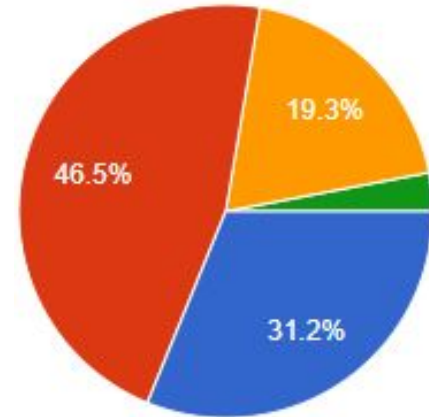
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LEVEL OF ENGAGEMENT

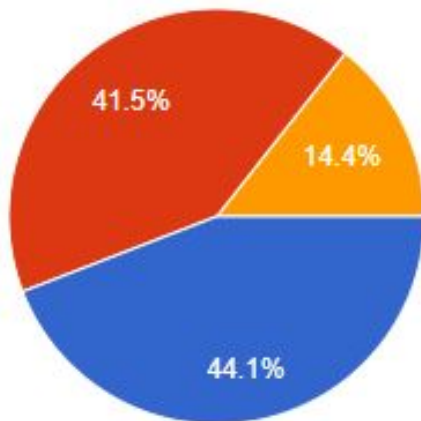


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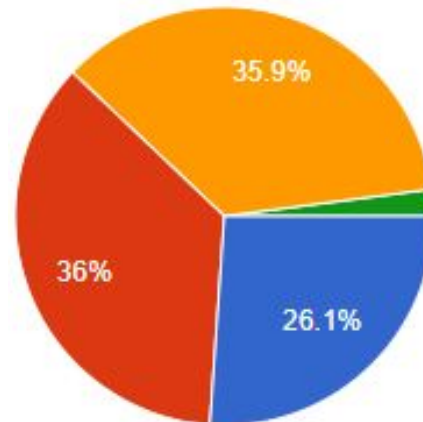
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LEVEL OF ANXIETY/STRESS

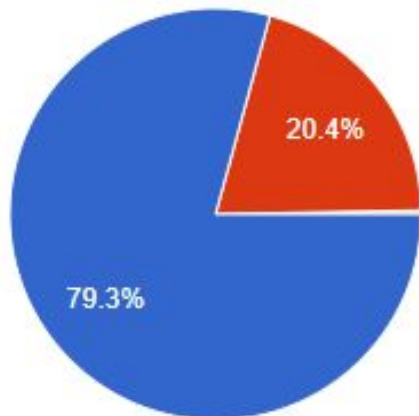


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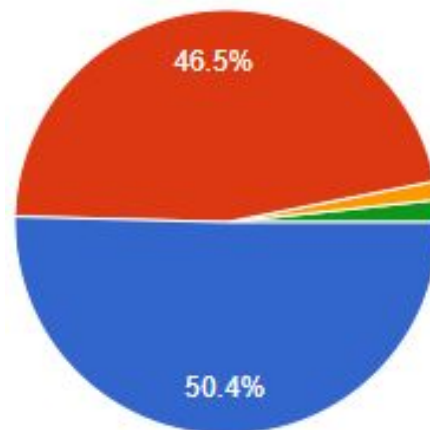
AMOUNT OF SCREEN-TIME

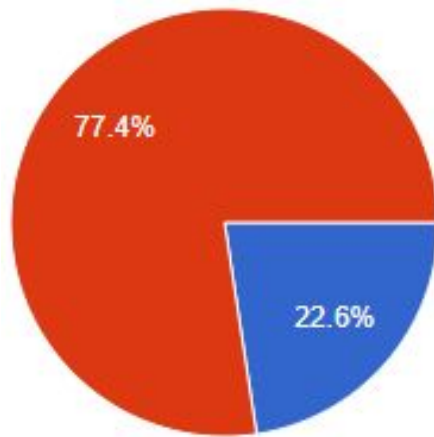


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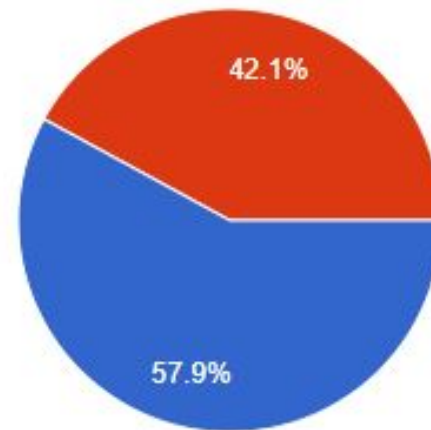
DAILY CLASS SCHEDULE FOR DISTANCE LEARNING

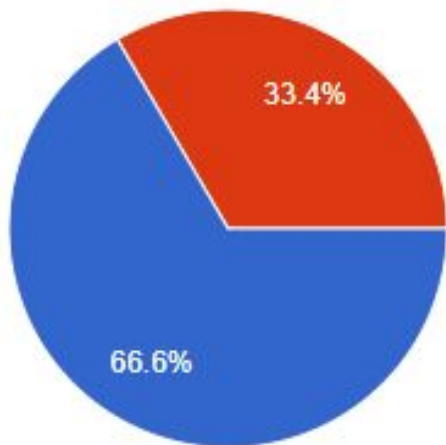


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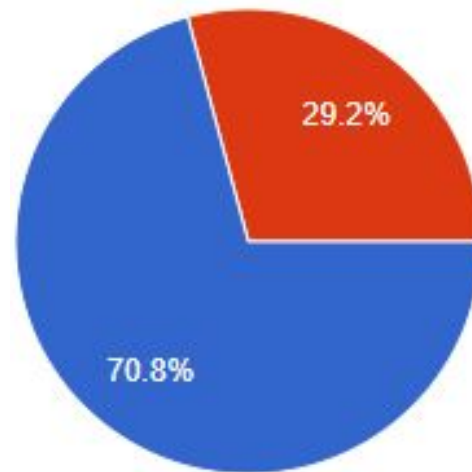
